



Dear Student,

Are you interested in participating in the 2025 TDK Competition (Scientific Students' Associations Competition)? You can find all the information you need on how to apply for the 2025 University TDK Competition and all the important deadlines below:

APPLICATION:

Visit <https://tdk.iit.uni-miskolc.hu/> and select the **Registration** in the menu. When you have registered, log in by selecting **Login** and entering your log-in details (selected email address and password).

Go to **Application to the TDK Conference** and enter your personal data and the relevant information about your TDK paper.

Then print out the **Application Form**. After you and your consultant(s) have signed it, upload it via **Upload TDK Application Forms**. Please submit the original document to your institute's TDK supervisor.

The **Application Form**, which is also available from all institutes and on the faculty website, should be completed in full and sent in editable file format to **btktdk@gmail.com**. All applicants must also send a digital copy of the summary of the research paper in editable file format to **btktdk@gmail.com** using the template provided on the faculty website. As these summaries will be appended to the programme booklet, it is vital that the given template is used.

Application period: from 22nd Sept 2025 till 19th Oct 2025.

Finalised research papers must be uploaded in **PDF** format via the **TDK thesis, summary uploading** menu point at <https://tdk.iit.uni-miskolc.hu/> and to the MIDRA system, as well as in **Word** document format to **btktdk@gmail.com**.



2 bound copies of the research paper must be sent to the Institute of Applied Social Sciences (A/5 building 2nd floor 215). Please also send your papers by email to btb.attl@uni-miskolc.hu.

The deadline for submission: 17. November, 2025. 3:00 p.m.

The section meeting will be held on 26. November, 2025. 2:00 p.m.

The TDK competition at the University of Miskolc is open to both full-time and part-time students and there is no age limit. In contrast to previous years, only research papers which attain a minimum of 80 points will be eligible to participate in the national Scientific Students' Associations Conference, OTDK.

Applicants may also submit a detailed framework of a research paper to evaluate whether a particular field of study is worth pursuing further and in which direction further research should take in the future. Such applications do not qualify for the national competition.
